Cremation Scattering



Garden or trail options 2024/2025

A scattering may only occur in designated areas within the Cemetery and only with an Interment Permit, issued from the Cemetery Office, complete with a scheduled date and time.

What is scattering?

Scattering cremated remains within the Cemetery is done on dedicated land that will always remain as an official, permanent interment area. Due to the permanency of scattering, we strongly recommend that the decision to have remains scattered be thoroughly discussed and thought through in advance.

Scattering ashes is available within the Promontory Green or at the base of Dilworth Mountain, adjacent to the nature trail.

Promontory Green Scattering Garden

On each side of the garden, there is a memorial wall that provides an option to have a bronze memorial plaque mounted. One handful of cremated remains may be scattered amongst the trees and flowers. The remainder are placed in an ossuary by the caretaker following the scattering. These remains will become co-mingled as is custom-ary. Booking: Scattering can be booked Mon-Fri from 9:30 a.m.-2:30 p.m. Bookings must be made two business days in advance. Scatterings can be booked after 3 p.m. or Saturday for an additional fee.

• Dilworth Mountain Scattering Trail

The Cemetery offers a unique opportunity to scatter ashes anywhere along the 1/3 km nature trail at the foot of Dilworth Mountain. This beautiful, natural area offers views of the forest and the city. Stone pillars overlooking the city provide an option to have a bronze memorial plaque mounted. In this area, all of the remains can be scattered along the trail. Booking seven days a week from 9:30 a.m. until 2 hours before park closes.

• **Memorial Plaque only** - a memorial plaque can be purchased by anyone wishing to memorialize an individual that is not interred at the Kelowna Memorial Park Cemetery.
