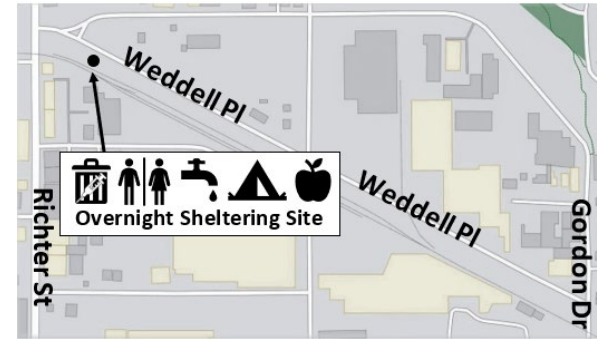

Outdoor Sheltering in Kelowna

Overnight Sheltering Site

(735 Weddell Place/890 Baillie Ave)

The City has designated a space for outdoor overnight sheltering until more space is available in emergency shelters or housing.

- Permitted areas for shelter set-up are clearly marked and available all day.
- Users must abide by all posted guidelines and decamp when required.

Guidelines

- Any structures, other than a tent, are not permitted. This includes building or assembling living spaces.
- Tents must be temporary and separated by at least 10 feet.
- Use of the site should not occupy a space more than 12' x 12'.
- Tarps should not be used to connect or cover multiple tents.
- Fire and open burning of any kind is not permitted.
- When temperatures reach -10 for more than two nights, the City will enact warming measures.

Metro Drop-In (1262 St Paul St)

The Metro Drop-In is a place to be for the day where you can access washrooms, light breakfast and lunch, and onsite storage. The Café and courtyard are open for drop-in Monday to Friday **9 am–4 pm**

BGCO Downtown Youth Centre - 1633 Richter St

For youth 13-18 years old. Services include dinner, showers, laundry, and general activities. Open Monday-Friday from 3pm-8pm.
