Preservation of Bellevue (Sawmill) Creek Corridor and Crawford Falls

APPROVED December 3, 1991

RESOLUTION: R375/10/04/26
REPLACING: R342/99/04/26; R1803/91/12/03
DATE OF LAST REVIEW: April 2010

THAT residential development at Crawford Estates be set back on both sides of the Crawford Falls trail so that houses are not visible from the trail;

AND THAT the City urge the Province to set aside the Bellevue (Sawmill) Creek Canyon and adjacent lands as a linear park connecting the City to the Kettle Valley Railway right-of-way and ultimately to Little White Mountain.

REASON FOR POLICY

Policy initiated by the Linear Parks & Pathways Committee in order to ensure preservation of the creek corridor and falls.

LEGISLATIVE AUTHORITY

Environmental Development Permit section of OCP.

PROCEDURE FOR IMPLEMENTATION
